1. Don't be afraid to toot your own horn.

- Be perceived as a manager capable of making the tough decision regarding staff
- Management must know you know what needs to be done and have a plan to get there

6. Demonstrate you know how and can make tough business decisions

- Don't allow your self to get caught in "paralysis by analysis"
- You may never have all the data to be 100% sure of a decision
- Good managers can take risks, make decisions and take responsibility for those decisions

7. Be prepared to act boldly

- Accept the fact that some decisions may be very visible within the organization
- Be willing to be in the limelight

8. **Demonstrate** *commitment*

- Be sure management sees you as someone who will do whatever is required to get job done
- Be prepared to make sacrifices in your personal life if company demands require it

9. Be sure your style conveys authority

- Watch yourself in a mirror and have others you trust give objective feedback on your delivery
- Practice public speaking and body language before key group presentations
- Insure you look confident, well prepared, well versed in your material look comfortable
